That's why Miami-Dade County Commissioner Eileen Higgins is launching the Elevate District 5 Program.

Elevate District 5 is Commissioner Higgins' comprehensive recovery and growth plan that utilizes data and feedback to create, leverage, and expand existing small business programs and tools to support and strengthen small businesses in District 5. The program is funded by the American Rescue Plan (ARPA), President Biden's plan to provide direct relief to Americans and rescue the economy.
